It was a process, but we are finally administering trade permits through the Fenton Township Office.

The Building Department staff has developed the permit applications and processes for electrical, mechanical and plumbing permits.

You can find the new Fenton Township trade permit applications at the Township office or on the website.

April is National Safe Digging Month.

This is a great time to remind everyone to contact MISSDIG before starting any project. In Michigan, you can call 8-1-1 or report online at missdig811.org.

Additionally, April 14-20 is National Public Safety Telecommunications Week. We want to thank the Emergency Center staff for their commitment, service and sacrifice for the safety of our community.

The Southern Lakes Water Extension Project is in full swing. Phase I is live – residents and businesses are now able to start the process of connecting to municipal water.

Reconstruction along Phase I will be completed this spring. After completion of pre-installment checks, installation of Phases II and III are ongoing this spring and making steady progress.

Sign up for e-billing Utility Invoices

Fenton Township is offering e-billing services for utility invoices.

So, what is e-billing?

If you sign up for the Fenton Township utility e-billing, rather than getting the blue and white postcard in the mail with your invoice for sewer, and now water for those connecting to the Southern Lakes Water Extension, you can receive

your invoice via email.

With e-billing, you will no longer have to worry about which of the billing cycles you are on at the Township to keep an eye on the mail. The invoice will arrive in your email inbox.

This is a great option for those that spend parts of the year at a different location, as the post office does not forward the

postcards to your forwarding address.

You can sign up for e-billing by stopping by the Fenton Township Office and filling out the e-billing form, or you can register on the Fenton Township website.

On the How Do I? drop down menu on the Fenton Township home page select e-billing for utility bill under the Sign Up For subcategory.

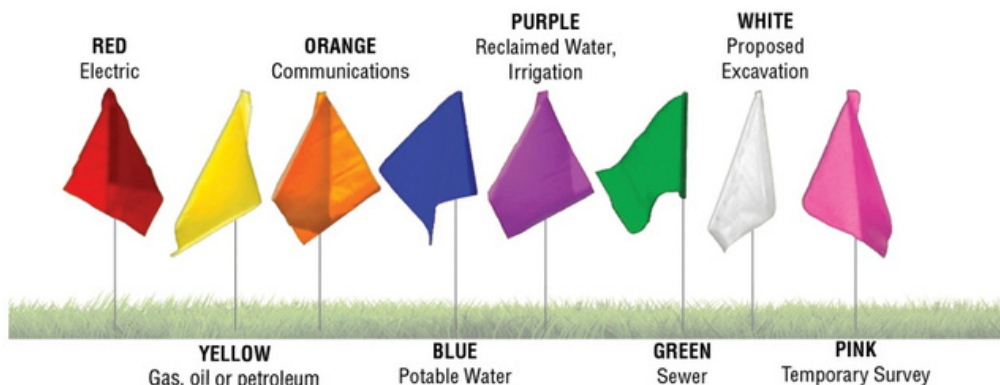
1 Contact MISS DIG by calling 811 or online at missdig.org

2 Wait 3 business days for utilities to be marked

3 Check marking status online to confirm all utilities have been marked

4 Respect the marks - know where & what facilities are in your workspace

5 Hand dig when digging within 4ft. of paint or flags



Call MISSDIG Before You Dig

Contact MISSDIG either online at missdig811.org or by phone by dialing 811.

It takes three business days for the utilities to be marked in your working area. You can check the status online.

Be sure to know your flags! The green sewer flags are the only ones placed by the Township, the others are placed by their jurisdictional representatives.

Only hand dig within 4 feet of the flags/paint.

Township Hall Rental: Booking into 2025

The Fenton Township Civic Community Center, located at the north end of Lake Fenton, is home to the Fenton Township Hall.

The Hall known mostly for hosting Fenton Township meetings, including Township Board meetings, is also a popular spot for rentals for events.

The full hall can accommodate up to 200 guests and includes a floor to ceiling view of Lake Fenton.

Newly remodeled in 2023, the hall can now be rented

by the half size for smaller events.

Additional Hall rental information can be located on the Fenton Township website, including copies of the rental agreement contract.

The Hall has some weekends available this fall and has started booking events into 2025.

Fenton Township Administering Trade Permits

Fenton Township is now administering trade permits through the Building Department at the Township office.

Projects taking place in the Township will no longer go through the State of Michigan for the following permits:

- Electrical
- Plumbing
- Mechanical

All three of the trade permits are now available at the Township office, along with on the Fenton Township website.

AMP Mosquito Control

Mosquito control for Fenton Township is through AMP.

The 2024 Mosquito Control Program Overview is available on the Fenton Township website. Residents are able to fill out a No Spray Request Form to submit to AMP.

Residents can call AMP at 810-766-9423 to request to be added to the call list to be notified prior to fogging in their area or to schedule their up to three property treatments per year.
