Water Main Project Update: Phases I, II, and III



Fenton Township is the latest extension of the Genesee County Water System (GCWS).

Construction for the project is currently being worked on along the south side of Thompson Road between Torrey Road and US-23.

The map above shows each of the three different phases of the project with Phase I being in yellow, Phase II in orange, and Phase III in red.

Phase I

The project started at the Fenton Township and

Mundy Township line on Fenton Road. Southbound on Fenton Rd to Thompson Rd. Then west on Thompson Rd and then will jog around the US-23 ramps.

Phase II

South on Torrey Road from Thompson Road to Lahring Rd. Then west on Lahring Rd to Jennings Rd, then back north to Thompson Rd.

Phase II allows for all four of the Lake Fenton School district buildings to be connected to the water system.

Phase III

This final phase of the project will continue west on Lahring Rd to Ripley Rd to connect the Genesee County Water System and the City of Linden.

2023 Summer Property Taxes Due Sept. 14

After September 14th additional interest and fees apply.

You may pay your 2023 summer property tax at the Fenton Township Office by means of check, cash, or money order.

There is no card reader at the Township Office. Payments may be made via credit or debit card online on the Fenton Township website, there is a processing fee of 3% of the payment amount with a minimum fee of \$3.95. American Express is not accepted for property tax payments.

Credit Card Payment Option Coming To The Fenton Township Office This Fall

At the Township front desk the question is asked daily, "Can I pay with a card?"

The response has always been a little lackluster in that yes you can pay with a card online for your sewer bill and your property tax payments; however, there has never been a card reader at the Fenton Township Office.

This fall the target for having a card reader available at the Fenton Township Office front desk.

Residents and contractors will be able to use a debit or credit card to pay for sewer bills, property taxes, hall rentals, dog licenses, building permits, etc. at the front desk with the new card reader system.

There will be a processing fee with the new system as well.
