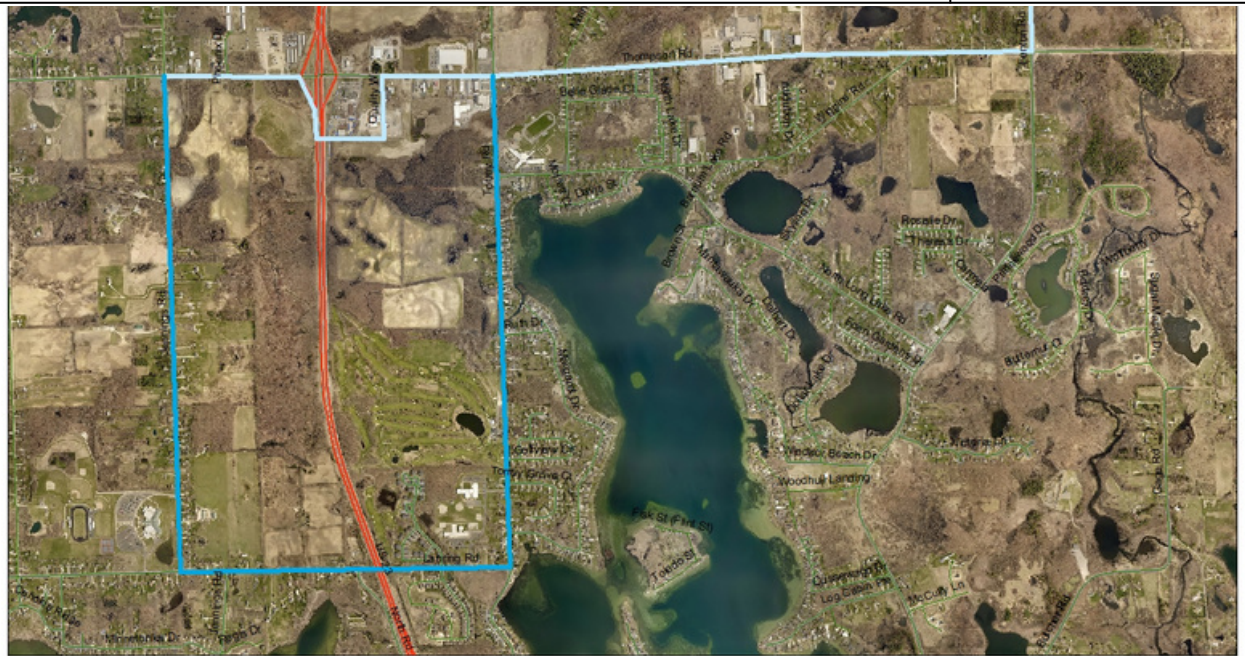

## Fenton-Thompson Watermain Extension Project

The Genesee County Drain Commission is leading the Fenton-Thompson Watermain project, as the project is an extension of the Genesee County Water Supply System that will bring water to the southern area of Genesee County.

In October 2021, the Genesee County Board of Commissioners allocated \$6.5 million to the project from the American Rescue Act Funds (ARPA) that the county received.

The watermain project is part of the development plan for the Thompson Road Corridor and the updates to the Fenton Township Master Plan taking place via the Planning Commission throughout 2023. The water system will bring options to homeowners, businesses, and the Lake Fenton School District buildings that are located within the Thompson Road Corridor.

In addition, the project will allow for new business development within the Thompson Road Corridor and be an option for further development of the park space on Thompson Road that currently is home to the Thompson Road Regional Dog Park to include more offerings for the community.

## Watermain Project Phase 1 and Phase 2

### Phase 1

Having broken ground in late November 2022 on Fenton Road. The first phase of the project will extend from the Mundy Township board south on Fenton Road to Thompson Road. The watermain will then continue west along Thompson Road to Jennings Road.

### Phase 2

The proposed second phase would see the watermain head south on Torrey Road (from Thompson Road) to Lahring Road then west to Jennings Road and back north to Thompson Road.

Phases 1 & 2 will bring the water system to all four Lake Fenton School District buildings.

### Winter 2022 Property Tax

The Winter 2022 Property Taxes became available on December 1, 2022.

The 2022 taxes are due to the Fenton Township office by close of business on February 28, 2023.

There is no card reader at the Township Office. Payments may be made via credit or debit card online on the Fenton Township website, though there is a processing fee.

Check or money order payments may be mailed or dropped off at the Township Office. You can either have it processed over the counter or in the afterhours drop box. Cash payments are accepted at the Township Office.

The Township Office will be closed January 2nd and 16th.

Payments not made by close of business on February 28, 2023 will be rolled over to the Genesee County Treasurer's Office.

### Heading out of State?

Stop by the Fenton Township Office and fill out a Vacation Check form. This way the Genesee County Deputies are aware and they can check on your property while you are away.

If you will be gone for several months, you will want to fill out a change of address form to have the sewer bills, tax bills, or other Township communications mailed to the address in which you can be reached. The United States Postal Service does not forward sewer bill postcards.

You may sign up for e-billing for the sewer bill so that the bill is emailed to you rather than receiving a post card.

## Curbside Waste Collection

The 2023 Republic Services collection schedule is now available.

With the new contract for Republic Services, yard waste collection has been extended through the end of December for 2023.

Yard waste will be collected weekly in 2023 starting April 7th.

Recycling is still every other week and that is dependent upon if you are in the yellow or the blue section of the map (these did not change for 2023 from 2022; however, the map is available on the Fenton Township website or in the Township Hall lobby.

For large item pick up, you need to call Republic at 888-872-7455 to schedule a large item pickup prior to collection that week.

## Plots Available at Gage Cemetery

Did you know that Fenton Township owns and operates a cemetery?

After many years of inactivity, a new section of Gage Cemetery was surveyed in the late 1990's and has been available for use since that time.

Gage Cemetery is located on the east side of Fenton Road between Thompson and North Long Lake Roads.

The newer section is located immediately south of the old part of the cemetery, which was established in 1856. Burial plots are available and may be purchased at the Fenton Township office.

The cost of an individual burial space is \$400.00.
