

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FENTON  
RESOLUTION NO. 2024-01**

WHEREAS, the homestead of persons who, in the judgment of the Board of Review, by reason of poverty, are unable to contribute to the public charges is eligible for exemption in whole or in part from property taxation under Public Act 390 of 1994 (MCL 211.7a), and

WHEREAS, the adoption of guidelines for property tax poverty exemptions is within the purview of the Township, and

WHEREAS, said Public Act 390 of 1994 requires the governing body of the assessing unit to determine and make available to the public the policy and guidelines for granting of poverty exemptions under said Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to Public Act 390 of 1994, the Township Board of the Charter Township of Fenton hereby adopts the attached ***Financial Hardship / Poverty Exemption Official Policy - 2024*** as guidelines for the Assessor and Board of Review to follow in granting or denying property tax hardship exemptions.

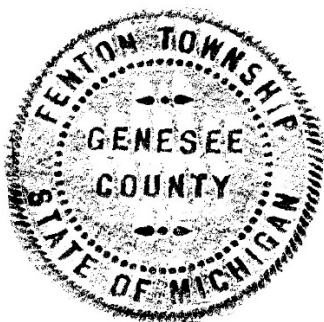
