The FTFD was established in 1975 as an on-call department. In 1996 the Township hired its first full time Fire Chief who is also the administrator of the Department.

The FTFD is committed to the education of the children within the Township. We have a "Safe at Home Program" in the schools to educate them on fire safety.

Our Department is equipped with automatic external defibrillators (AED's) for cardiac arrests and we have a thermal imaging camera to detect fires inside of walls and other areas not seen by the human eye.
