PLASTIC REFERENCE GUIDE

 <p>Plastic soft drink & water bottles, catsup, mouthwash and salad dressing bottles. Peanut butter, may, pickle, jelly and jam jars.</p>	 <p>Catsup bottles, yogurt containers, margarine tubs, medicine and vitamin bottles, etc.</p>
 <p>Milk, water, juice, shampoo, dish and laundry detergent bottles; yogurt containers, cereal liners, grocery, trash and retail bags.</p>	 <p>Compact disc jackets, food service applications, egg containers, aspirin bottles, cups and plates.</p>
 <p>Clear food and non-food packaging, medical tubing, electrical cable insulation, plastic pipes, fittings and carpet backing.</p>	 <p>Three and five gallon reusable water bottles, some citrus juice and catsup bottles.</p>
 <p>Dry cleaning, bread and frozen food bags, squeezable bottles (mustard, BBQ sauce, etc.).</p>	<p>*See bottom of container for plastic type</p>
