Great Lakes Waste Services is pleased to provide waste removal services to the residents of Fenton Township. We are committed to providing our customers with the best service possible. ### **YOUR SERVICE INCLUDES:**

#### Trash Collection

Unlimited household trash pick up in plastic bags, which may be placed at the roadside or placed inside trash cans at the roadside. Please do not put trash to the roadside in cardboard boxes or trash containers without handles. Also for no additional cost, we will provide you with compost (seasonal) and recycling pick up ONLY if it is available in your area.

#### Composting (same day as trash collection)

Unlimited yard waste pickup in brown paper yard waste bags, or in cans that are clearly marked "compost" or "yard waste". Branches 3" in diameter or less must be cut in 4' lengths or less, tied and bundled (limited to 5 bundles per week). We DO NOT take logs, stumps, dirt, rocks, or sod. NO PLASTIC BAGS WILL BE ACCEPTED! Compost/yard waste is picked up between the dates of April 1st and November 30th only.

#### Recycling (same day as trash and compost collection)

Great Lakes will provide you with a recycling bin. Please do not use cardboard boxes or other trash containers for recycling purposes. The drivers will not pick up recycling unless it is in a "Great Lakes Waste Services" recycling bin. Please place your recycle bin away from your trash so that the drivers can visibly see your recyclables from the road. The following is a list of items that can be recycled and preparation procedures.

**Newspapers:** Place in a brown paper grocery bag or tie and bundle with string. We do not take phone books, magazines, cardboard, box board (cereal boxes, tissue boxes) or glossy newspaper insets.

**Plastic:** Plastic bottles #1 & # 2, rinsed with lids and labels removed. No motor oil, anti-freeze, or cooking oil containers. No plastic bags or any other item containing a different recyclable number.

**Glass:** Clear and colored glass, rinsed with lids and labels removed. No broken glass, light bulbs, or mirrors please..

**Cans:** Tin and aluminum cans, rinsed with labels removed. No aluminum oils or can lids.

### Large Item Pick Up

Great Lakes will pick up one large item per week such as a chair, television, couch, stove, or 5 small rolls of carpet 4' in length weighing less than 60 lbs. tied and bundled, or 2 trash cans of construction material weighing less than 60 lbs. etc. Please call if you have any questions regarding the items you want picked up.

Refrigerators, freezers, and any other appliance containing Freon must be tagged by a certified appliance repair technician that the Freon has been removed. Without the tag, there will be no pickup.

### Holiday Schedule

If a holiday falls on or before your scheduled pick up day (Monday-Friday), service will be rendered one day later for the remainder of the week. The following holidays may affect your pick up:

New Years Day  
Memorial Day  
Independence Day  
Labor Day  
Thanksgiving Day  
Christmas Day

If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday your trash service will not be delayed that week and all services will run on schedule.

All trash, recycling and compost are to be placed at the roadside no later than 6:00 a.m. on the day of your scheduled service.
