DEMOLITION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed, signed, and dated permit application
- Detailed site plan showing soil erosion boundary and structure intended for demolition
- Soil Erosion permit issued by Genesee County Drain Commissioners
 Office
- Signed letters issued from Consumers Energy stating all gas and electricity has been shut off and/or disconnected at the demolition project site.
- Any sewer contractor who intends to cap or connect to the sewer line within Fenton Township must be registered with the Fenton Township office. Please call (810) 629-1537 for further information. Please keep in mind that your demolition permit will not be issued until your sewer contractor has been registered with this office.
- Demolition permit fee is \$100.00, and if the property is connected to sewer, it is required to be cut & capped. An inspection of the cut & cap is required before backfilling that area. An invoice for the cut & cap sewer inspection fee of \$150.00 will be required to be paid at the time the demolition permit is issued.
- If you plan to reconnect the sewer in the future, there is a \$500.00 fee to reconnect to the existing sewer lead. This amount includes your reconnection inspection and will be on a separate invoice and will be due at the time you pick up the new construction permit.
- If you have a well and/or septic system on your property, you are required to contact the Genesee County Health Department regarding the disconnection (cut/cap) of both systems, and provide proof of inspection to this office. Please call (810) 257-3612 for further information.
- Please make note that whoever applies for, and physically signs the
 demolition permit application will be considered to be individual held
 responsible for this project. This office will NOT get involved in any type of
 legal matter regarding any contract held between the contractor, subcontractors, and/or property owners.
